

FROM THE DESK OF OUR DIRECTOR OF MUSIC, MONROE QUINN

"Please join in singing..."



"The woods would be very silent if no birds sang except those who sang best." -Henry Van Dyke

Every weekend, I play the music for at least five Masses, not including

weddings, funerals or as a substitute for other organists at nearby parishes. While playing so many Masses can indeed be demanding, I feel strongly that being a Director of Music is a position that is an honor to have. In addition to always working to improve my playing, as well as accompanying each cantor to the best of my ability, I will sometimes take a moment to look out at YOU, the congregation. For instance, if a parishioner doesn't sit in their "usual pew," it catches my attention. Or if a 10:30 am family suddenly shows up at a 5:00 pm Mass, it can put a brand-new spin on my whole weekend! But the main thing I watch for among the assembly is to see if people are singing.

My primary mission, besides being liturgically correct and picking music that is in line with Msgr. Hubba's vision for our parish, is my desire for people to sing. Because the first two qualifications should be "no brainers" for any Director of Music, the third one, the people's sung participation at Mass, is paramount. When the priest speaks the words "The Lord be with you" we respond as a matter of course "and with your Spirit." Suppose the celebrant *chanted* this instead of speaking it? We would respond by *singing* the reply, "and with your Spirit." With song we are still praying, just with words set to notes. *Sung prayer is still prayer.*

Sing to the Lord: Music in Divine Worship, the official document on the function of music at Mass published in 2007 by the USCCB states:

"The full and active participation by all the people is the aim to be considered before all else, for it is the primary and indispensable source from which the faithful are to derive the true Christian spirit."

This is why, when introducing a new piece of music, the cantor and I almost always rehearse it with the congregation prior to Mass—to give everyone a chance to be familiar with the melody and encourage all to sing.

For those who don't sing at Mass, perhaps singing isn't your "thing." I get it. I am one of the world's worst dancers. (Only slightly better than Elaine on *Seinfeld.*) So, if it were dancing instead of singing that was encouraged at Mass, I would be extremely uncomfortable doing so.


Which leads me to the quote which opens this article. Henry Van Dyke composed the lyrics to the popular hymn, "Joyful, Joyful We Adore Thee," with melody supplied by Beethoven. If we were to paraphrase Van Dyke's beautiful words, we might find ourselves sadly saying "Saint Joseph Church would be very silent if no parishioners sang except those who sang best."

But do be mindful of singing TOO well at Mass. Several of our current adult choir members were recruited because I heard them singing beautifully from the pews—and we've got some seats left!

HIS HOLINESS, POPE EMERITUS BENEDICT XVI 1927-2022

- Born Joseph Aloisius Ratzinger April 16, 1927
- Ordained Priest June 29, 1951
- Ordained Bishop Archbishop of Munchen und Freising -May 28, 1977
- Created Cardinal-Priest of Santa Maria Consolatrice al Tiburtino - June 27, 1977
- Appointed Prefect of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith November 25, 1981
- Created Cardinal-Bishop of Velletri-Segni April 5, 1993
- Confirmed Dean of the College of Cardinals -November 30, 2002
- Elected Pope Benedict XVI April 19, 2005
- Inaugurated Petrine Ministry April 24, 2005
- Resigned Papacy February 28, 2013
- Entered Eternal Life December 31, 2022



As a priest, Ratzinger was regarded as an academic scholar. He was a professor of Theology at universities, and a prolific writer. Among his many writings were three Encyclicals.

Deus caritas est on December 25, 2005 "God is love"

Spe salvi on November 30, 2007 "In hope we are saved"

Caritas in veritate on June 29, 2009 "Charity in truth"

He participated in the Second Vatican Council as a theological advisor. After being elected Pope, he realized the best way to reach Catholic communities, was to travel to them. Pope Benedict visited the US in 2008. Then in 2013, Pope Benedict felt he didn't have the physical strength to carry out the duties of the position, and became the first Pope to resign the Papacy in 600 years.
