What is Cornerstone?

Cornerstone is a retreat presented annually by parishioners with the intent to build each participant's spirituality and to connect them with the St. Joseph's community.

It is called "Cornerstone" referring to Christ being the Cornerstone, the foundation upon which our lives are built. On the weekend, you will experience a focused atmosphere where you can initiate, deepen or revitalize your relationship with Christ, in a welcoming environment.

Many of us attend Mass, but because of our busy lives, find it hard to connect to our community of faith and have a close connection with others in our parish. Spending this time at a Cornerstone retreat will give you the opportunity to make these connections with God, and with others.

Who Can Attend Cornerstone?

St. Joseph's Cornerstone is open to men and women of all Christian faiths and is held annually (one for men and one for women). You may wish to invite a family member or friend to attend with you.

What Will I Experience on the Weekend?

The retreat takes place in St. Joseph's Retreat House and begins at 7 p.m. on Friday evening. All meals (lovingly prepared), and plenty of snacks will be provided.

The weekend activities will help you to affirm your own gifts and discover how you can use these gifts for the good of others. It is a fun way for church members to get to know each other and build lasting bonds of support and trust.

There are short presentations followed by small group discussions, quiet personal time, and Reconciliation. Everything shared on the weekend is held in strict confidence. There is also time for fun and relaxation. The weekend concludes with a Family Mass at 8 p.m. on Saturday evening. Family and friends are invited to attend. This is a weekend of great surprises, prepared especially for YOU! Every team member is dedicated to ensuring an atmosphere of warmth and hospitality.
