



I wanted to take this opportunity to extend my gratitude to all of you who participated in our in pew survey several weeks ago. We received over 550 results and over 125 written comments from surveys across all our weekend Masses. As we look to the future at Saint Joseph Parish, guided by the Holy Spirit, one of the purposes of the survey was to hear where our parishioners thought we should focus attention by prioritizing five categories (1 most important – 5 least important) The results are displayed in the graph below.




Faith Formation was most important in 328 surveys, Social Concerns & Outreach was most important in 103 surveys, followed by Improvement Projects, Worship and Other. As a priest, I think it is excellent that we have a strong desire to deepen our spiritual lives and have made faith formation the top priority! Truly, all of the other categories are dependent on and grow out of our desire to grow closer to the Lord and the invitation to spread the Good News to our families, friends, and members of our local community.

This information and the helpful comments that we have received, including those suggesting some improvements to our parish facilities, are valuable as we develop a plan for the future. As we share this feedback with various ministries, councils, and committees these themes will help to guide our work. There are many initiatives centered around Faith Formation and Social Concerns & Outreach here at Saint Joseph that can help us become even more faithful disciples of the Lord. In the coming months, we plan to share information related to these initiatives and invite all to participate! Truly, the Catholic faith is very much alive here at Saint Joseph's and I am blessed to minister to you all. Thank you for your love, dedication, and kindness that you show to our parish.
