

We have ordered safety railings that will be put by the two steps in the Church parking lot! We expect the railings to be installed by the end of the month.








To date 109 parish families have pledged a total of \$58,523, which is 72.46% of our assigned parish goal of \$80,762.

#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. CHRISTIAN SCALO



Well...it's getting close! Palm Sunday is just around the corner and then we enter into the most sacred times of Holy Week and the Easter celebrations. I hope that these last few weeks of Lenten preparation have been fruitful for you and your families... but if not,

don't worry! It's not too late! God is always ready to meet us where we are and help us get closer to Him any day, any time, any place. We go through these days together as one Church, one parish family of Saint Joseph and we support each other along the way.

As I've been reflecting on the Passion of Christ lately. the word "fasting" keeps coming into my mind. After all, by suffering on the road to Calvary and by hanging on the cross, Jesus performed the ultimate acts of self-denial. He gave himself completely for us, denying himself comfort and security so that we could be saved. Prior to really going deeper into my faith in the seminary, whenever I'd hear the word "fasting" especially during Lent, the first thought that came to mind was "great I get to loose weight!" Give up chocolate, soda, some type of food and bam... results. Oh how short sighted I was! See, fasting is way more than just giving something up and hoping for some helpful physical benefit (as good and welcomed as those side effects are!). Fasting is the art of giving something up - food, entertainment, some comfort for the sake of filling ourselves with Jesus, imitating His actions of self-denial, and developing spiritual self-discipline along the way.

Just think, if we let something go and replace it with nothing there's a void! Take TV for example. If we give up watching an hour of TV a day, that means theoretically there is still an hour left with nothing to do! That hour could be used for anything, but the best thing to fill it with is something that strengthens our faith. After all, the Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are meant to boost our faith and trust and hope in God. Maybe in place of TV (or whatever it is you're fasting from) it's a bit of scripture reading. Maybe it's some silent prayer. Maybe it's using that time to help other people in need or a combination of the three or more!

As we begin to close out our Lenten preparations and look forward to Holy Week and Easter, I invite all of us as a community to embrace the Lord's call to draw nearer to Him, to carry our crosses with faith, and to look for ways to support one another as brothers and sisters in the Lord.






