

Blessings and peace to you and to your families on this Divine Mercy Sunday, the Second Sunday of Easter! I hope you all have enjoyed your Easter celebrations. You know, it's important for us to celebrate these Easter days and to celebrate them well as Catholic

Christians. It's one of many reasons that our faith is so special. We are people of the Resurrection! People who believe that Jesus conquered death once for all and opened for us the path to eternal life with Him. We don't just love for today or for what we can see with our own eyes... we live for such a brighter future prepared for us with the Lord. We are people who believe that every life is valuable, indeed purchased at a great price by the blood which flowed from the crucified and risen Christ.

A letter from **Fr. Christian** about our Raffle has been mailed to parishioners.


