

## FROM THE DESK OF FR. CHRISTIAN SCALO



And so it begins...we are now entering into Holy Week, the most sacred time of year for us as Catholic Christians. The events that we celebrate on Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, the Easter Vigil (and of course, Easter Sunday) are central to our faith.

The Life, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus are everything. We believe in a God who loves each one of us so much that He came down from Heaven, "the Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us" (John 1:14). He walked this Earth with gentleness and compassion-restoring sight to the blind, giving healing to the sick, and even raising the dead like He did for Lazarus. He gave a second chance to the woman caught in adultery. He converted the great persecutor of the Christians, Saul and allowed him to become St. Paul- one of the greatest evangelizers known to man. And even while suffering Himself on the cross in agony, He promised the repentant thief hanging on a cross beside Him a place in the Kingdom, "...today you will be with me in paradise" (Luke 23:43).

God loves you. He truly does. We are the people that Jesus had in His heart while He was suffering on the cross. Jesus knew that we couldn't earn salvation ourselves- the debt of the ancient sin was too great. So with love He offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice and not only that, rose from the dead three days later, giving us a path to redemption and forgiveness even now through the Church's Sacraments.

My friends, use these days of Holy Week to enter deeply into the mystery, each day moving closer and closer to Easter. If you're available, come to the Mass on Holy Thursday, the service on Good Friday, and even the Easter Vigil (I know it's long, but if you've never seen it before it's an absolutely beautiful experience that you won't forget). These are the most solemn days of our Church year and each day has a uniqueness in liturgy that you just don't see any other day. May we as the parish community of Saint Joseph draw closer to God and to one another in these most sacred of days. God Bless you.

abstinence. When fasting, Catholics (age18 until age 59) are permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. **Abstinence** from meat that day is required of Catholics age 14 and onwards.


