A note from Fr. Christian



We are God's children, made in His image and likeness. Each one of us, without exception, has been uniquely created and molded throughout our lives by God to be the people that we are. We have different personalities, appearances, interests, skill sets,

experiences... the list goes on! But one thing that we all share (besides our common humanity and all that goes with it of course) is that we all have been given a name. When I was younger and even now for that matter, I could recognize instantly when one of my parents or friends called my name. I'm sure the experience is similar for you as well. We respond when our name is called! It's something that is ingrained into our minds. Our name is deeply connected to who we are as people and having it known by others, especially by the people that we love, can fill us with a deep sense of love and connection.

The Lord Jesus gently calls the name of each one of us and asks us to follow Him as disciples, walking the road of faith with its twists and turns, and trying to do so better and better each day. Jesus knows our name, just as He knows the depths of our hearts, and we recognize His voice because He is the One who made us. God's voice is very distinct to the human heart and soul. It's unmistakable. Like the Scripture says, "...the sheep listen to his voice. He calls His own sheep **by name** and leads them out. When He has brought out all his own, He goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow Him because they know His voice" (John 10:3-4).

When the Lord calls, we are invited to respond with generous hearts. Sure, that's not always easy! Especially these days, there's so much "background noise" in our lives from social media, various forms of entertainment, work/home issues, that it is difficult to hear God's voice in the first place! And after that... responding with a "yes" can be equally if not more challenging. Yet the invitation to follow Christ remains and is always freely given. The starting point is simply to have an open heart and a desire to have stillness and peace enter our hearts. To wake up in the morning with a positive and hopeful attitude that no matter what happened yesterday or what's going to happen today or what we're afraid is going to happen tomorrow... that God's voice will always lead us in the right direction and point us toward what will bring true happiness and peace. Eternal happiness, peace, and security comes from God and God alone: the world with all the "stuff" it has simply cannot give it the way God does. How blessed we are to be the sheep of such a Good Shepherd who said, "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand" (John 10: 27-28).


