In response to these guidelines, beginning on Pentecost Sunday, St. Joseph Church will return to offering the precious blood at Mass to anyone who wishes to receive from the chalice. There will be two chalices, one on each side with a Eucharistic minister. Since we are not sure how many people will wish to receive, we will make appropriate adjustments as we go along.

SAINT JOSEPH PARISH HAS EXCEEDED ITS GOAL




Thank you to all those who have helped Saint Joseph Parish reach our 2023 Annual Appeal goal of \$80,762.

grateful to all of our donors for supporting our Parish!




St. Joseph School 8th grade class

While the RCIA process is primarily for adults seeking baptism, adaptations are made for baptized Christians of other denominations who are seeking to join the Catholic Church, and for baptized Catholics who are seeking to complete their initiation into the faith.
