The Archdiocese of Newark has released guidelines rolling back a number of restrictions that were put into place due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In response to these guidelines, beginning on Pentecost Sunday, St. Joseph Church will return to offering the precious blood at Mass to anyone who wishes to receive from the chalice. There will be two chalices, one on each side with a Eucharistic minister. Since we are not sure how many people will wish to receive, we will make appropriate adjustments as we go along.

If you have pledged but have not yet sent your check, please be sure to fulfill your pledge as soon as possible. All pledges must be paid by June 30 in order for our parish to qualify for a 2% reduction in our parish assessment, which is a savings of approximately \$15,000 and the parish will get back 50% of all monies received beyond our goal.

A note from Fr. Christian



"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me. In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come

back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be. Where I am going you know the way" (John 14:1-4).

Such beautiful words of peace and comfort from the Lord. Just think... God cares for each one of us so much that He wants to give us a special place with Him forever.
