

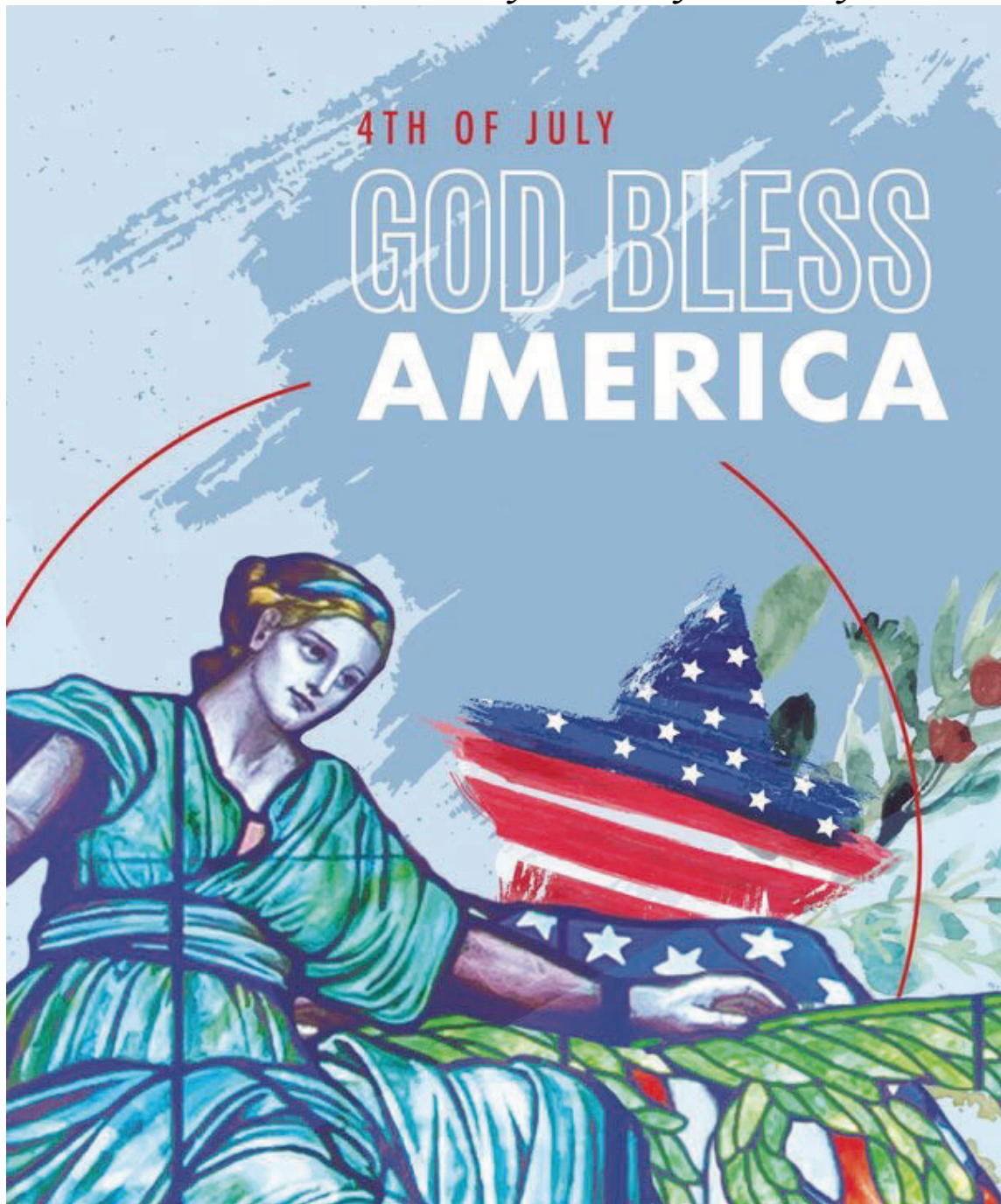

## A note from Fr. Christian



In a few days, we as a nation will celebrate the Fourth of July, a day dedicated to recognizing our independence and freedom as a nation. A special thank you to all who currently serve or have served in the military and their families. We honor the sacrifices

that you all have made to keep our country safe and preserve the liberty that we cherish as Americans. You know... the concept of freedom is not only related to public or civil matters, but also is deeply rooted in our spirituality as Catholics. The freedom that we speak of is not and cannot be given by any individual or group, nor is it a freedom given so we could simply "do whatever we want when we want"... it is so much deeper and more beautiful than that. True freedom is a gift promised and given by God himself which most fundamentally allows us to choose to move toward that which is good and to reject that which is evil. It is meant to be used in loving service of one another (see Galatians 5:13) and is a sign of the presence of the Lord in our midst, for "... the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is there is freedom." 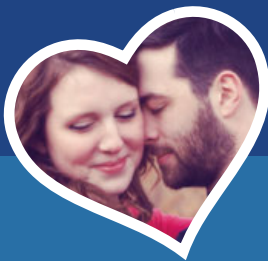
