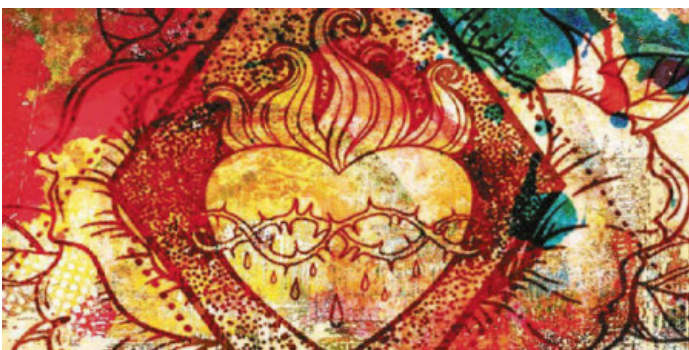
A note from Fr. Christian



Today as a parish community we celebrate together with the Universal Church, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. The Eucharist, the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ is the center of our Catholic faith; truly the **real presence** of Christ, *not* merely a symbol or representation. Although we see bread and wine with our human senses, we are actually beholding and receiving the real body and blood of Jesus. What a privilege that we have each week at Mass to have the opportunity to encounter Jesus in this profound way! WE ARE ALMOST AT THE FINISH LINE

The Parish has only \$2,294 remaining in Unpaid Pledges. All pledges must be paid in full by June 30 in order for the Parish to receive a 2% reduction in our parish assessment, which is a savings of approximately \$15,000. The Parish will also get back 50% of all monies received beyond our goal of \$80,762. Pledges to date total \$91,908, which would mean that the parish would receive a rebate of \$5,573. 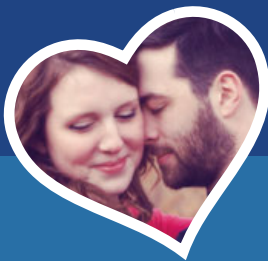
