A note from Fr. Christian



The heart of Jesus is full of compassion and mercy. He looked with love on the woman caught in adultery and gave her a second chance at life, he brought healing to the paralytic and to the blind men restoring them to health, he forgave the repentant thief on the

cross opening the gates of the kingdom to him. The Scriptures describe such beautiful encounters with the gentle Redeemer. When he saw the large crowds of people in today's Gospel, Jesus' heart was *"...moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned like a sheep without a shepherd"* (Matthew 9:36). I find it tremendously comforting that the heart of Jesus beats for you and for me; that Jesus wants to reach out to us and to bring his Sacred Heart near to our own heart; that God wants us to experience healing and newness of life each and every day.

We've all had different experiences this past week. Perhaps take a moment to bring some of them to mind now. I'm sure some of them were really good, maybe a handful were "neutral" and others maybe not so great. Sometimes we're up, sometimes we're down, and sometimes we're right in the middle. If this has been a week of excitement and joy, that's awesome! Jesus is with you celebrating too. If this week has been a challenge... maybe things didn't work out, maybe anxieties were high... maybe loneliness was setting in... Jesus is with you too in the midst of the struggle. Jesus never leaves our side no matter what our present "situations" might be- he is always with us through thick and thin, in good times and in bad, when we are at our best and when we need to be carried along and shown the right way to go. He showed us the depth of his love for each and every one of us by offering his own life on the cross, conquering sin and opening for us the path to redemption. Now that's love. *"No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends"* (John 15:13).

God gives us opportunities to do all of those things... our job is to seize those moments and make the commitment to ourselves and to God that we will follow his guidance wherever it leads us. May God bless you and your families this coming week and know that whatever happens... you always have a friend in Jesus.

WE ARE SO CLOSE TO THE FINISH LINE

The Parish has only \$194 remaining in Unpaid Pledges. If all pledges are paid in full by June 30, the Parish will receive a 2% reduction in our parish assessment, which is a savings of approximately \$15,000. The Parish will also get back 50% of all monies received beyond our goal of \$80,762. Pledges to date total \$92,258, which means that the parish would receive a rebate of \$5,748.

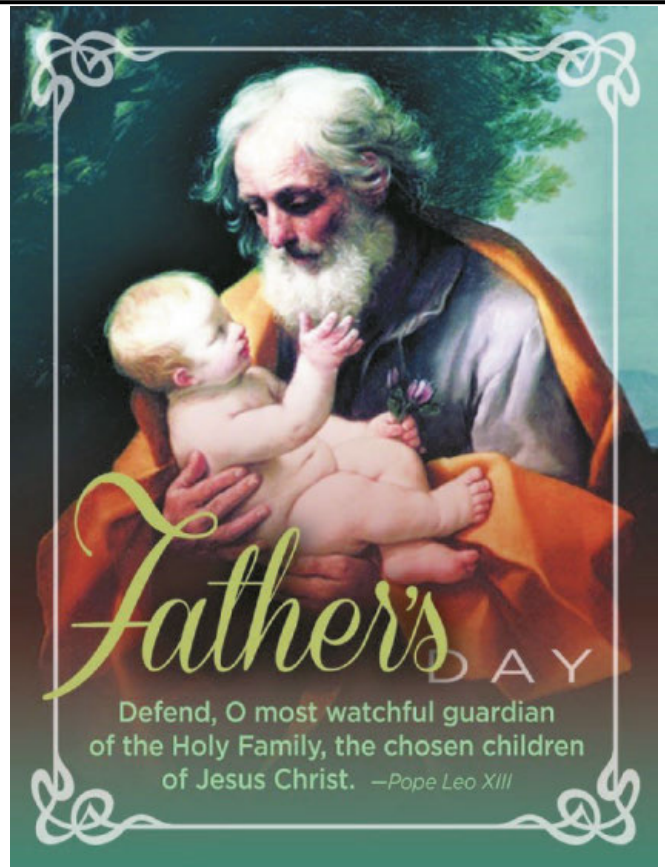

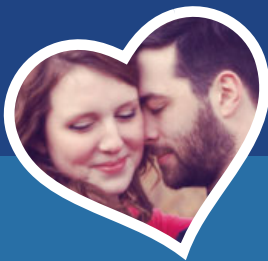
