

#### WE DID IT!

Thank you to all the parishioners that donated to the Annual Appeal. Because of your generous and overwhelming response, the Parish has surpassed its goal in PAID pledges. This means that the Parish will receive a 2% reduction in our parish assessment, which is a savings of approximately \$15,000. We will also get back 50% of all monies received beyond our goal of \$80,762. Pledges to date total \$92,828, which means that the parish would receive a rebate of \$6,033.


