#### A note from Fr. Christian




When the cares of our lives become heavy, where do we turn? On those days when we feel like giving up, what helps us get through? In whom do we put our trust? Our lives are complicated and it can feel like sometimes we are being pulled

in so many directions and have so many concerns that there aren't enough hours in the day to address them all! We might be facing a difficulty at work or home, maybe someone we care for is having a hard time in life and we want to help, perhaps our own minds are suffering from anxiety or fear over one thing or another. It's common for people to try to find some relief in the things of the world: self-help books, social media, other forms of entertainment. But eventually, even the best of "worldly solutions" falls short. The most secure, guaranteed place to find refuge is in the arms of Jesus.

Jesus wants to help us carry the burdens that we face in our lives. We will never be free of struggles... they're just part of living life and being human. But, Jesus invites we who are weary and burdened to come to him, and promises that we will be given rest (see Matthew 11:28-30). Jesus will help us stay strong in the midst of adversity, give us wisdom for making important decisions, and send hope in times where things seem bleak. "Cast all your worries upon him," the Scripture says, "because he cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7). We can be confident that Jesus will help us throughout our lives precisely because he cares for each one of us. He showed the level of his care, how far he would be willing to go for us, when he suffered, died, and rose again to give us a path to eternal life with him. God will look out for you and for me always. Our job is to exercise our muscles of faith and to have the courage to ask him to come into our heart and help us carry our crosses.


