A note from Fr. Christian



Anxiety is a very real experience for many of us these days. Whether it's "the fear of missing out" that so many of us feel in the era of social media and instant communication, or the concerns we might have trying to support our

family/friends through difficult times, or the fear and nervousness brought on due to any other particular reason (insert your situation here.... the sky is the limit!), our minds and hearts seek security and certainty. To know that everything will be ok. To feel like we are not alone in our struggle, but are supported and loved all the way through.

SAINT JOSEPH PARISH IS JOINING THE ARCHDIOCESAN ROSARY CONGRESS OCTOBER 12, 2023


SIGN UP FOR AN HOUR: OR JUST SHOW UP!


