





There are a lot of things that can come to mind when we think of a King. Perhaps its an image of a man from a movie or cartoon show, dressed in purple flowing garments, wearing a golden crown, holding a scepter in his hand as he sits confidently upon

a marble throne. It could be an image of a strong dictator who looks down on his subjects as he rules his kingdom with little concern for the individual lives of his people. Or... we could imagine a benevolent king, one who rules with gentleness, kindness, and compassion. A person who gives and sacrifices himself for others. A person who desires to know and to love each and every person he serves.



Please join us in Saint Joseph's Retreat House behind the church. (Follow the signs) We look forward to seeing you.


