Dear Parents,

The celebration of infant baptism is a joyous occasion for that child's family and for the family of the Church. Baptism celebrates the fact that God loves us so much that God calls us to have a special, personal relationship with Him. A relationship so close that God claims us as His own and gives us the privilege of calling Him "Our Father!" Just as the birth of a child leads parents to reflect on the gift of human life, so the baptism of a child leads parents, and the whole parish, to reflect on this sacrament and what it means to be a part of God's Church.

Preparation Class takes place in the Upper Church on the Saturday listed on the schedule. The importance and meaning of the Sacrament of Baptism is explained. In addition, there is a rehearsal of what will take place during the Celebration of Baptism. Godparents are strongly encouraged to attend this session.

Celebration of Baptism

Baptisms take place at 1:30pm on the designated days on the attached schedule. The Sacrament of Baptism (the first of the Sacraments of Initiation) washed away all sins, original and personal, bestows new life (see Catechism of the Catholic Church #1279). Through the sacrament, the newly Baptized becomes a member of the Church and is configured to Christ; being sealed the indelible spiritual mark on their belongings to Christ (CC#1272).

The requirements for being a godparent set by the Catholic Church are attached. Please review the requirements carefully as you consider a person to be the godparent for your child.

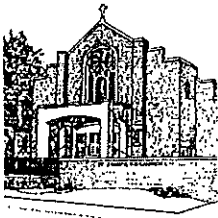
PARISH REGISTRATION You must be a registered parishioner of Saint Joseph Parish to have your child baptized at our parish, unless arrangements are made with the priest. According to Church Law, sacraments can only be celebrated with those who are members of the parish community. You will be asked to provide your Parish Registration Number, which is found on your weekly envelopes. If you are not a registered parishioner, your **first step** is to contact the parish office, 201-261-0148, to register with the parish.

Enclosed is the Baptism Schedule and Registration Form. Please complete the form and choose the dates for your class and baptism. Godparent Sponsor Certificate forms are due when you register for the Baptism Program.

Keep in mind that your child's godparent is a partner with you in the religious upbringing of your child. Therefore a godparent needs to be a Catholic in good standing with the Church. This means they must be a registered parishioner in a Catholic parish and attend mass regularly. The godparent must obtain and submit a letter or certificate of sponsorship from the parish where they are currently registered and attend Sunday Mass. This document states that the godparent is a practicing Catholic in good standing with the Church. The document must have the Parish Seal. Some parishes have a form and some write a letter. Sacrament records are not the required document.

A GODPARENT MUST COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ *Be at least 16 years of age and be persons who will share, support and help the child grow in his/her relations with God by their presence in the life of the child and by the witness of their Christian life.*
- ◆ *Be Roman Catholics who have received the sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation;*
- ◆ *Be persons who participate in the spiritual life of the Catholic Church by weekly attendance at Sunday Mass and regular reception of the sacraments;*
- ◆ *If married, their marriage is recognized as valid by the Catholic Church;*
Note: This means--If the person was not married by a priest, the marriage is not recognized by the Church and that person may not be a godparent.
- ◆ *Godparents may be one male and one female; or just one male or just one female. You may not have two godparents of the same sex;*
- ◆ *A non-Catholic may be a Christian Witness; however that person must be a Christian, who was baptized "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Such a person is considered a Christian Witness. They will be designated as a Christian Witness in the Parish's Baptismal Register and on the Baptismal Certificate.*
Note: A Sponsor Certificate is not required for a non-Catholic Christian Witness.
- ◆ *Persons of the Jewish, Muslim, Hindu, Buddhist faith, etc, and non-believers **cannot** be godparents, since they obviously do not profess in Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord, nor can they assist in passing on the Christian faith to the child being baptized.*
