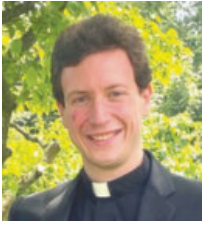

Recently I've been pondering... without the internet, our computers and phones would lose a majority of their practical use. It's by being CONNECTED that they're able to link us with friends and relatives over long distances, help us to find information, and even send a simple text message.

The best and most powerful connection we have ever had and ever will have... is our connection to Jesus. Through our Baptism and participation in the Sacraments, we become connected to Jesus in a very special way as his disciples on mission. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) launched a three-year national Eucharistic revival in 2022. It is a movement to restore understanding, and devotion, to the great mystery of the Eucharist here in the United States, by helping us renew our worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Right now, we are in the "Year of Parish Revival", which is June 11, 2023, to July 17, 2024. St. Joseph Church has responded by offering our mission in October, and in January, **Jesus in the Eucharist** was offered. One Monday evening study and one Tuesday morning study took place. The response of those who participated in the study was overwhelmingly positive, especially when it came to group sharing. We would like to offer this study one more time before the Congress in Indianapolis from July 17-20.

**Jesus and the Eucharist** is a dynamic, 7-session study designed to help you connect with your fellow parishioners as you fall deeper in love with our Eucharistic Lord. Immerse yourself in the beauty of our faith in an intimate small group setting, hear from some of the most brilliant voices in Catholicism, and explore the mystery of the Eucharist anew as a part of the National Eucharistic Revival.

We are hoping to have either a Monday or Tuesday Morning session from 9:30-11:30 AM and either a Monday or Tuesday evening session from 7:00 PM-9:00 PM. Other times will be considered if there is enough interest. There is no cost or preparation involved. The two-hour video includes scripture and prayer, two separate lessons from expert speakers from the Augustine Institute, each followed by approx. 20 min. sharing time which is counted down on the video. If all goes well, these sessions will begin the last week of April or the first week of May. They will likely be held in the Retreat House or the Parish Life Center. 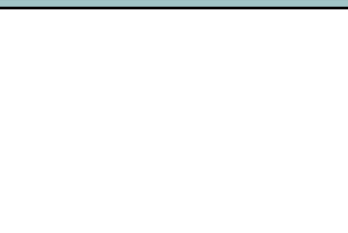
