

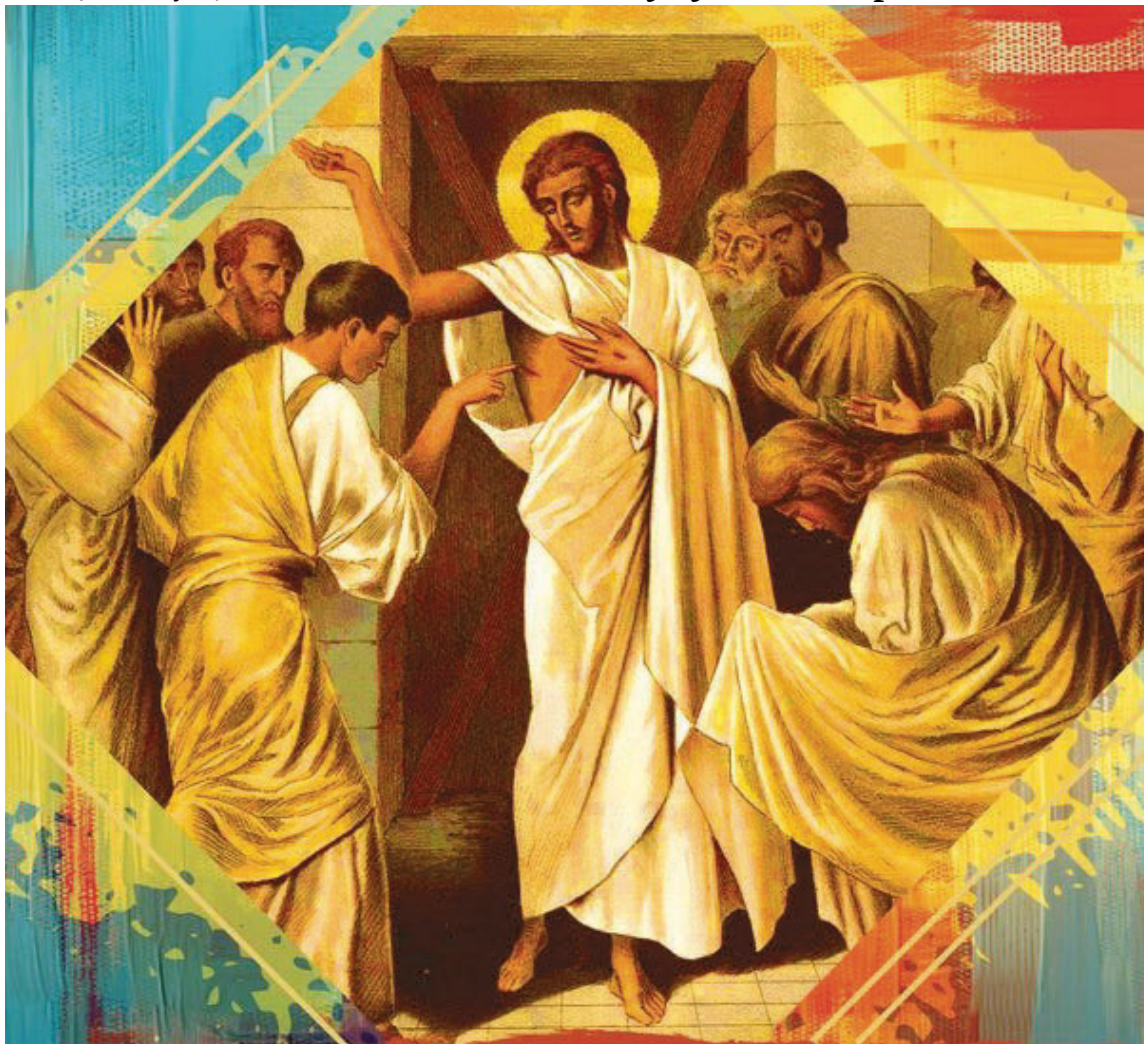

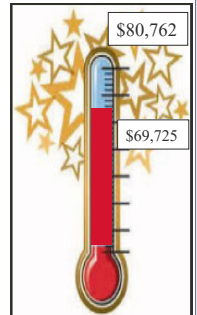

This Sunday, the Second Sunday of Easter, is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. 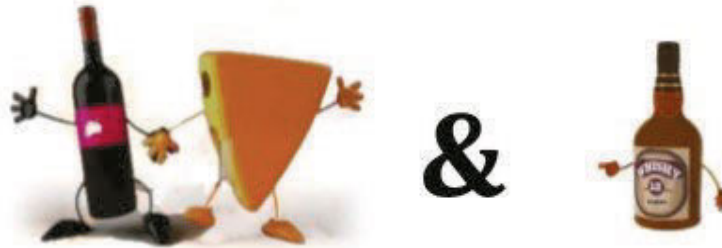
