

Authenticity is so important! If we think about the people whose opinion we value the most, the people we like to be friends with, or even the people we might work the best with, it's likely that one

common denominator between all of them is that we perceive them as being real and authentic people. One who is authentic is not afraid of being the person that they truly are: they don't put on airs or try to be someone that they are not. They say what they mean, and mean what they say!

For us as disciples of Jesus, our deepest and most authentic identity that we share is as beloved sons and daughters of God. The Lord calls us each by name to be his witnesses to the world, to experience conversion in our own mind and heart, and to help others experience the peace and love of Jesus Christ. We can do that most effectively when we allow Jesus to enter into the deepest parts of our life, and when we are humble enough to be vulnerable with Him.

Sometimes when we've gone through some suffering or hardship in life, we can develop a rough "outer skin" to protect ourselves from getting hurt again. But when we're in the company of Jesus, we can feel safe in letting him love our whole self, even in our weaknesses.

Growing in Faith and Knowledge: Excerpts from the Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

In this new section of the bulletin, we will highlight different teachings found in the Compendium, with the hope that it helps all of us to grow in basic knowledge of our faith, thereby leading us closer to Jesus!

Why is faith a personal act, and at the same time ecclesial?

Faith is a personal act insofar as it is the free response of the human person to God who reveals himself. But at the same time it is an ecclesial act which expresses itself in the proclamation, "We believe". It is in fact the Church that believes: and thus by the grace of the Holy Spirit precedes, engenders and nourishes the faith of each Christian For this reason the Church is Mother and Teacher.

"No one can have God as Father who does not have the Church as Mother." (Saint Cyprian)

In what way is the faith of the Church one faith alone?

The Church, although made up of persons who have diverse languages, cultures, and rites, nonetheless professes with a united voice the one faith that was received from the one Lord and that was passed on by the one Apostolic Tradition. She confesses one God alone, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and points to one way of salvation. Therefore we believe with one heart and one soul all that is contained in the Word of God, handed down or written, and which is proposed by the Church as divinely revealed.
