

#### A note from Fr. Christian



So here we are at the Second Sunday of Advent! I hope this past week has been spiritually fruitful for everyone. Undoubtedly it's a busy time of year, but also a very beautiful and exciting one. Jesus is coming! And we need to be ready.

"He went throughout [the] whole region of the Jordan, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, as it is written in the book of the words of the prophet Isaiah:

"A voice of one crying out in the desert: 'Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths" (Luke 3:3-4).

Repentance is one of the cornerstones of the Catholic life and is a significant form of spiritual preparation that was preached by John the Baptist even before Jesus came (see above). As he grew, Jesus spent much of his public ministry forgiving and healing people, inviting them to conversion. He would never turn anyone away who approached him with a sincere, repentant heart. The same is true today, most especially in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Jesus delights when we come to him and ask for forgiveness and invites us to love and trust him.

At times, we've all made mistakes, missed opportunities, and not acted our best. Rather than holding on to the guilt and the burdens caused by sin, rather than keeping things in the dark.... perhaps we all can take an opportunity this Advent to bring those places of pain into the light and to receive the healing of the Lord's mercy and forgiveness. Allow Jesus to set you free.

#### Growing in Faith and Knowledge: Excerpts from the Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

In this new section of the bulletin, we will highlight different teachings found in the Compendium, with the hope that it helps all of us to grow in basic knowledge of our faith, thereby leading us closer to Jesus!

#### In what way does God reveal that he is love?

God revealed himself to Israel as the One who has a stronger love than that of parents for their children or of husbands and wives for their spouses. God in himself "is love" (1 John 4: 8.16), who gives himself completely and gratuitously, who "so loved the world that he gave his only Son so that the world might be saved through him" (John 3:16-17). By sending his Son and the Holy Spirit, God reveals that he himself is an eternal exchange of love.

#### What does it mean to believe in only one God?

To believe in the one and only God involves coming to know his greatness and majesty. It involves living in thanksgiving and trusting always in him, even in adversity. It involves knowing the unity and true dignity of all human beings, created in his image. It involves making good use of the things which he has created.

#### What is the central mystery of Christian faith and life?

The central mystery of Christian faith and life is the mystery of the Most Blessed Trinity. Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
