The OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults), formerly known as the RCIA, is a process in the Church that allows baptized Catholic adults to complete their Sacramental

initiation into the Church, those baptized in other Christian faiths to become Catholic, and those who have not been baptized to enter into the Church at Easter! These past two weekends, our parish was blessed to bring many adults to the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Newark to celebrate the Call to Continuing Conversion and the Rite of Election (see the many pictures online at our community page!). Both of these celebrations are milestones in the formation process for adults who desire to enter fully into the Catholic Church or who desire to convert to Catholicism.

This year, we are so privileged to have many adults in our OCIA program, including one person who will receive the Sacrament of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil, thereby becoming a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church. It is inspiring to have so many people who desire to share our faith and I am grateful to Melinda Rabbia and Fred Fakharzadeh for their dedicated work with our OCIA members.

If you or anyone you know has not fully completed their Sacraments or would like to become Catholic, please do not hesitate to reach out to us! God is calling all of us to deeper conversion and the OCIA is a beautiful starting point for many to get closer to Jesus: "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, [then] I will enter his house and dine with him, and he with me" (Revelation 3:20).

Growing in Faith and Knowledge: Excerpts from the Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

In this new section of the bulletin, we will highlight different teachings found in the Compendium, with the hope that it helps all of us to grow in basic knowledge of our faith, thereby leading us closer to Jesus!

Why did the Son of God become man?

For us men and for our salvation, the Son of God became incarnate in the womb of the Virgin Mary by the power of the Holy Spirit. He did so to reconcile us sinners with God, to have us learn of God's infinite love, to be our model of holiness and to make us "partakers of the divine nature" (*2 Peter* 1:4).

What does the word "Incarnation" mean?

The Church calls the mystery of the wonderful union of the divine and human natures in the one divine Person of the Word the "Incarnation". To bring about our salvation the Son of God was made "flesh" (*John* 1:14) and became truly man. Faith in the Incarnation is a distinctive sign of the Christian faith.

In what way is Jesus Christ true God and true man?

Jesus is inseparably true God and true man in the unity of his divine Person. As the Son of God, who is "begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father," he was made true man, our brother, without ceasing to be God, our Lord.


