## A note from Fr. Christian



I am truly amazed that we are already in the Season of Lent! Lent is a time for us to look deep within ourselves and to open ourselves to the grace of Jesus in a special way. Each Lent, we undoubtably hear about the practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving,

each of which special in their own right, but when practiced together, can help us to really move deeper into our spiritual life. Lent can be a really challenging time... after all, we live in a world of "instant gratification" and our Lenten practices really are about denying ourselves and looking to love and serve others more like Jesus did.

It all starts when we make the decision, right now at the beginning of the Season, to make this Lent different from the past. Perhaps we've set out to give up something or do something extra during Lent before and found that we weren't able to fully keep the commitment. Or maybe in the past we've chosen to do or forgo something that is "easy" for us instead of picking something that's more challenging. Whatever our past experiences of Lent have been... THIS time we have a chance to really do something special and keep our commitment to God.

One powerful way to start the Season off right is to take the opportunity to make a good Confession: to allow God's forgiveness to enter into our lives in a profound and transformative way. God is gentle, loving and kind- waiting to bestow his mercy upon us when we acknowledge our sins in the light of His love and turn to him for forgiveness. Jesus always welcomes us with open arms. We will have a Lenten Penance Service this coming Monday, March 10 beginning at 7pm with many priests joining us to help. This is a great opportunity for deep healing at the start of Lent and I hope many can join us!

## Growing in Faith and Knowledge: Excerpts from the Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

In this new section of the bulletin, we will highlight different teachings found in the Compendium, with the hope that it helps all of us to grow in basic knowledge of our faith, thereby leading us closer to Jesus!

## **How is the Good News spread?**

From the very beginning the first disciples burned with the desire to proclaim Jesus Christ in order to lead all to faith in him. Even today, from the loving knowledge of Christ there springs up in the believer the desire to evangelize and catechize, that is, to reveal in the Person of Christ the entire design of God and to put humanity in communion with him.

## What is the meaning of the name "Jesus"?

Given by the angel at the time of the Annunciation, the name "Jesus" means "God saves". The name expresses his identity and his mission "because he will save his people from their sins" (*Matthew* 1:21). Peter proclaimed that "there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we can be saved" (*Acts* 4:12).

## Why is Jesus called "Christ"?

"Christ" in Greek, "Messiah" in Hebrew, means the "anointed one". Jesus is the Christ because he is consecrated by God and anointed by the Holy Spirit for his redeeming mission. He is the Messiah awaited by Israel, sent into the world by the Father. Jesus accepted the title of Messiah but he made the meaning of the term clear: "come down from heaven" (*John* 3:13), crucified and then risen , he is the Suffering Servant "who gives his life as a ransom for the many" (*Matthew* 20:28). From the name Christ comes our name of *Christian*.
