A note from Fr. Christian



The great feast of Palm Sunday is here, as well as the beginning of the most sacred week that we experience as Catholics. This Holy Week, we have a tremendous opportunity to really enter into the deepest aspects of our faith, walking in the footsteps of Jesus through His suffering, death, and Resurrection.

That day when Jesus was crucified, there were many who fled; most of His disciples were scattered, except for a few. Their faith was shaken that day and Jesus knew it would be! He even told them, *“this night all of you will have your faith in me shaken...”* (Matthew 26:31). There are many moments in our life when we can feel that our faith is shaken. There are times where we can really feel overwhelmed by fear, confusion, or simply by our own weaknesses and limitations. The answer is not to run away from any of those things, but rather, to remain with Jesus as we work through them. After all, despite the pain of Good Friday, we know that there is the bright light of Easter Sunday and the Resurrection that we can look forward to: that beautiful day of triumph, victory, and new life.

I encourage all of us to do our very best to make this week distinct from any other in the year. If you are available on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil, I highly recommend joining us for those liturgies. Personally, I have always found them to be wonderful moments of renewal and grace.

God will bless us with abundant graces this Holy Week, if we make room in our heart to receive them! May we receive the invitation to enter this week with devotion and respond with a generous YES.

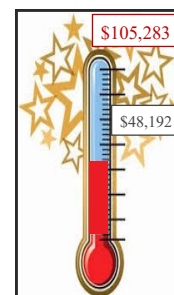

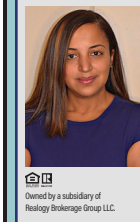
